


Student and Family Information Packet

How to register on Pledgestar and start fundraising

Fundraising begins Monday, January 8 to Thursday, February 8,

<u>Using your computer's browser:</u>

- Go to http://pledgestar.com/olinda
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event".
- Enter your name and email address, then click "Submit".
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Runner(s) and add family and friends.

Using your Android or Apple phone or tablet:

- Go to the Apple App Store on iOS or the Amazon App Store on Android and search for "PledgeStar" to download the Family App, or go to https://pledgestar.com/olinda/downloadapp.html.
- On the home screen enter your event code: "Olinda" to locate your event.
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event".
- Enter your name and email address, then click "Submit".
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Runner(s) and add family and friends.

Paying by check or Zelle:

- To avoid credit card fees, you may pay by Zelle (Olindaptofinance@gmail.com) or personal check.
- Please make checks payable to Olinda PTO and put the child's name and teacher in the memo. Please turn into the front office.
- Please mark the cash option on Pledgestar and pay by Zelle and put on the memo the child's name and teacher.
- No cash donations please.

What is the Olinda Jog-a-thon?

The Jog-a-thon is Olinda Elementary School's major fundraising event for the year. Students will be raising funds for the school and participating in an outdoor athletic activity.

Why are we fundraising?

All proceeds go towards supporting our students with the latest technology and educational enrichments. This includes assemblies, lessons in music, reading, art, field trips, media centers, STEAM learning, playground equipment, and more!

When is the Olinda Jog-a-thon?



The Olinda Jog-a-thon will take place on Olinda school campus on **Thursday, February 8, 2024 between 8:45 AM – 11:00 AM**. Donations for the Olinda Jog-a-thon will be accepted beginning January 8, 2024 through February 8, 2024. Check or cash donations must be turned into Olinda's Administration Office no later than February 8, 2024. 2:10 PM PST. Online donations can be submitted until February 8, 2024. 11:59 PM PST.



The Olinda Jog-a-thon will take place on campus, outdoors and on the grassy field. Additional parking will be available at the Brea Sports Park.

How long is Olinda Jog-a-thon?

The students will be on the track for approximately 15 minutes per grade level. Students will be escorted by their teachers to the class photo area first given time to stretch before the run. Each class will spend about 30 minutes total out of the classroom.

How are the raffle prizes drawn?

A virtual raffle ticket will be placed in a virtual pool. The raffle ticket will be drawn virtually to determine a winner for each raffled prize. The more raffle tickets a student earns, the more chances the students will have to win a raffled prize.

How do I earn prizes and raffle tickets?

Each Student can register on PledgeStar at https://pledgestar.com/olinda/. Send email or text pledge requests to your family and friends through PledgeStar and allow them to make secure donations online. Students can earn prizes based on the amount received and donation level reached.

If I registered to PledgeStar in previous years, do I need to register again?





Donating online is the most preferred, safe, and secured method, however check's may be submitted at Olinda's Administration Office. Please place checks in a sealed envelope with their full name and teacher's name to be eligible for prizes. All check and Zelle donations must be brought to the office before February 8, 2024, at 2:10 PM PST. Please note, check donations can be promised online on PledgeStar. Send Zelle donations to olindaptofinance@gmail.com with student's name and teacher in the memo.

What should students wear or bring?

All students should wear the provided Olinda Jog-a-thon T-shirt, comfortable shorts/pants, and shoes appropriate for running. Please note that this year is a Color Run. A non-toxic water-soluble colored powder will go on the runners. If they would like, please have them bring a labeled, reusable bottle filled with water.

Are families allowed to attend the Olinda Jog-a-thon?

A spectator section will be available where family and friends may take pictures and cheer for our runners. We encourage spectators to attend only during their student's timeslot.

Is there a minimum amount that my child needs to raise to participate?

No, there is no minimum. All donations are welcome. Every student will receive a FREE Jog-a-thon t-shirt! Students who do not raise funds can earn one raffle ticket by sending out 10 successful requests through PledgeStar. View the "Email Donation Request Sent" and "Status" on PledgeStar to ensure your request was sent successfully.

How can family and friends donate?

Family and friends can donate using PledgeStar, the school's online fundraising system. Students/Parents can enter family and friend's names, email addresses, or phone number to text messages. Pledge requests can also be posted on social media platforms (i.e. Facebook and Instagram).
